
As you are aware, on May 30, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against 321 Communications, Inc. in the amount of \$1,000 for violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report with the Commission and pay regulatory fees by May 1 each year. 321 Communications, Inc. failed to file its 2013 annual report or pay its 2014 regulatory fee and has incurred a penalty of \$1,000. The Commission sent 321 Communications, Inc. a Second Notice on June 25, 2014, and a Final Notice on July 26, 2014.

The Commission has not received the \$1,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
