

NOTICE OF ESTABLISHMENT OF QUIET ZONE

Notice is provided that **City of Connell** hereby establishes a 24-hour Quiet Zone in accordance with the regulatory provisions contained in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 222, *Use of Locomotive Horns at Public Highway-Rail Grade Crossings; Final Rule;* in particular, under authority of 222.39(a)(1).

We affirm that the Notice of Intent (NOI) was provided; mailed September 5, 2014. Compliance to applicable governing criteria was achieved, by proper installation of Supplemental Safety Measures (SSMs) as proposed.

DATE ISSUED - NOTICE OF ESTABLISHMENT (NOE): April 30, 2015

DATE UPON WHICH THE QUIET ZONE WILL BE ESTABLISHED: <u>May 21, 2015</u> Routine sounding of train horns at crossings shall cease within the Quiet Zone. The time period that restrictions will be imposed is 24 hours per day.
