The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) has completed its review of the preliminary draft of the Clark County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan Update (Plan).

The 2012-2017 Plan proposes to increase tip fees from 2013 through 2017. As a result, there will be a minor rate impact to ratepayers served by regulated solid waste collection companies in Clark County.
