This is to pay for the corrosion control treatment plant ordered to be installed by the Department of Health. The proposed effective date of the filing is April 1, 2015.

This plant is necessary to treat the water you receive and protect against possible lead and copper corrosion.

The assessment amount is \$4,586.00 per customer. The financing will be a ten (10) year contract at 8-1/2% interest. The customer's monthly payment will be approximately \$57.00 per month, but taxes of \$219.00 per customer will have to be paid up front.

The Commission has the authority to set rates that may vary from the Company's request, depending on the outcome of its investigation.
