

- 4 (2) Methow Valley Sanitation is a solid waste company and a public service company subject to Commission jurisdiction.
- 5 (3) Methow Valley Sanitation is subject to WAC 480-70-071, which requires solid waste companies to file an annual report by May 1 of each year.
- 6 (4) Under WAC 480-70-071 (1)(c), the Commission may grant an extension of time allowing the Company to file its annual report after the May 1 due date if the Commission receives a request for extension before May 1.
- 7 (5) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on April 30, 2015.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition filed in Docket TG-150622 by Methow Valley Sanitation on April 15, 2015, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes underlying the regulation and applicable statutes and should be granted.

O R D E R

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The request by Methow Valley Sanitation Service, Inc., dba WasteWise Methow for an exemption from WAC 480-70-071 and for an extension until May 31, 2015, to file its 2014 annual report is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Methow Valley Sanitation Service, Inc., dba WasteWise Methow to file its 2014 annual report by May 31, 2015, may result in the Commission invoking RCW 81.04.405, which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rule, and Commission orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Methow Valley Sanitation Service, Inc., dba WasteWise Methow to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
