Dear Judge Kopta:

I am responding to your Penalty Assessment Notice Letter ("Letter") sent and received by David Allen, CFO via email on June 28, 2016 requesting response within 15 days after receipt. The letter was in regards to the filing of Graebel's 2015 HGC Annual Report ("Report") and noted penalties in the amount of \$1,000, and the process to contest the penalty. In light of Letter request and following the facts/circumstances, Graebel is requesting that the WUTC excuse or reduce the penalty.

Graebel did not receive the report mailed on February 29, 2016 due to an address/location change. Graebel has provided notice to the WUTC of the mailing address change to 12790 Merit Drive, #400, Dallas, Texas 75251 on the 2015 HHG report.

Graebel did obtain a report from the WUTC's website around the renewal date and our accounting department gathered the information following a previous year's format and filed. As stated in the Letter (which still reflects Graebel's old 15455 Dallas Parkway address), Graebel's fee and Report was received by the WUTC on May 3rd, within one day of the May 2nd due date.

Unfortunately, the email that was sent on May 10th to my e-mail address from the WUTC went grouped as junk mail by Microsoft Outlook and being new with the company I did not realize that it was sent there until our CFO David Allen received an e-mail. However upon receipt of the letter I was able to track the email and am now promptly responding.

I have sent the corrected Schedule A to Mr. Bennett reflecting the intrastate mileage as 56120. Graebel has also received an invoice for a penalty in the amount of \$44.44 which was paid online on 07/07/2016 and the confirmation was sent to Sean Bennett today on 07/08/2016.

In conclusion, Graebel is requesting that WUTC considers the facts that May 10th email was not received, the address changes delayed the receipt of the letter and the company has promptly made a good faith effort to provide the information requested upon receipt of the June 28 Letter and waive the excessive \$1000 Penalty.

NOTICE OF PENALTIES INCURRED AND DUE FOR VIOLATIONS OF LAWS AND RULES

PENALTY ASSESSMENT: TV-160621 PENALTY AMOUNT: \$1000

According to Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) records, you have violated Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers companies to file their annual report and pay regulatory fees each year by May 1. May 1 was a Sunday, therefore you were required to file your annual report or pay regulatory fees by May 2, 2016. You did not file an annual report by May 2, 2016.

Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 81.04.405 authorizes the Commission to assess a penalty of \$100 for each violation of a Commission rule. In the case of a continuing violation, every day's continuance is a separate and distinct violation. The Commission interprets noncompliance with WAC 480-15-480 beyond May 2 as a continuing violation, and assesses penalties of \$100 for each day a company fails to file its report or pay its regulatory fees after that date.

As a result, the Commission has assessed penalties against you in the amount of \$1000 on the following basis:

On February 29, 2016, the Commission mailed the 2015 annual report forms and the 2016 regulatory fee packets to all household goods carriers companies registered in Washington. The instructions page for the annual report form instructed these companies to file annual reports and pay regulatory fees by May 2, 2016. The instructions page also stated that failure to file the annual report by May 2 would result in penalties. The deadline for requesting an extension to file your annual report was April 15. You did not request an extension.

On Tuesday, May 3, 2016, Graebel-Quality Movers LLC filed an incomplete 2015 annual report and paid its 2016 regulatory fee. The Commission reached out to the company via email on May 10 and advised Graebel/Quality Movers, LLC that "N/A" for the Interstate and Intrastate miles is insufficient and that these figures are required. As of May 16, the report remained incomplete. May 16 is ten business days from May 2, resulting in a total penalty of \$1,000. The Commission has yet to receive a complete and accurate annual report and additional penalties may accrue until you submit one.

Your penalty is due and payable now. If you believe the violation did not occur, you may request a hearing to contest the penalty assessment. The Commission will grant that request only if material issues of law or fact require consideration of evidence and resolution in a hearing. A request for a hearing must include a written statement of the reasons supporting that request. Failure to provide such a statement will result in denial of the request.

If there is a reason for the violation that you think should excuse or reduce the penalty, you may ask for mitigation (reduction) of this penalty through evidence presented at a hearing or in writing. The Commission will grant a request for a hearing only if material issues of law or fact require consideration of evidence and resolution in a hearing. Any request for mitigation must include a written statement of the reasons supporting that request. Failure to provide such a statement will result in denial of the request. See RCW 81.04.405.

If you properly present your request for a hearing and the Commission grants that request, the Commission will review the evidence supporting your dispute of the violation or application for mitigation in a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding, before an administrative law judge. The administrative law judge will consider the evidence and will notify you of his or her decision.

You must act within 15 days after receiving this notice to do one of the following:

- Pay the amount due.
- Request a hearing to contest the occurrence of the violations.
- Request mitigation to contest the amount of the penalty.

Please indicate your selection on the enclosed form and send it to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Post Office Box 47250, Olympia, Washington 98504-7250, within **FIFTEEN (15) days** after you receive this notice.

If you do not act within 15 days, the Commission may refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General for collection, which may file suit in state court to collect the penalty. The Commission may also initiate proceedings under WAC 480-15-450 to cancel your permit to operate as a household goods carrier in Washington.

Page 4 – Both Interstate and Intrastate operating miles are marked N/A. This is incorrect. Operating
miles (Intra and Inter) information is required. Please advise me of this information ASAP so I can
mark the annual report as complete.
