Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 30, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Friendly Mover LLC in the amount of \$400 for violations of WAC 480-15-560 and -570, which require household goods carrier companies to comply with Title 49 CFR Part 393. In May 2017, a Commission investigator conducted a compliance review of Friendly Mover LLC and found four violations of Commission rules. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated August 23, 2017, indicating that the balance of \$400 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$400 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$400 balance.
