Our company is filing a request to reduce the residential recycling rates. The recycling rates currently have a \$45 per ton processing fee included in them. In recent discussion with our third-party processor, Pioneer, they notified us that we will no longer be billed a processing fee. In lieu of this past practice the gross value of commodities will be reduced by the processing cost. The commodity credit filing we filed on January 15, 2018 (TG-180058) also reflects this change.

We project this will decrease revenue for residential recycling service by \$632,000 (15.85%) per year. There are approximately 55,800 residential customers affected by this change.

Attached are revised tariff pages and supporting documentation containing the revised rates. The audited and approved workpapers from the last general rate filing, TG-111688, were used for this filing. Removal of the \$45 per ton processing fee was the only change made to the previously approved model.

This filing is being filed under the provisions of WAC 480-70-262, tariffs requiring seven-day notice to the Commission. However, we ask that the revised rates not go into effect until March 1, 2018. This will allow for the reduced recycling rate and the new commodity credit to go into effect at the same time. We chose to file this filing before the seven-day window in order to give Staff sufficient time to review.
