Re: TV-180640 - Dismissing Application

Dear Transit Systems Inc.:

On July 26, 2018, Transit Systems Inc., d/b/a Moves for Seniors, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a Household Goods Carriers carrier in the state of Washington.

On January 24, 2019, the Commission sent Transit Systems Inc. notices describing the application requirements the company had not satisfied. Despite this notice, Transit Systems Inc. has not met the following requirements as of the date of this letter: Did not provide identification of applicants, did not provide proof of insurance, did not provide vehicle list. As a non-traditional household goods moving, Transit Systems Inc. needed to apply for exemptions from household goods moving rules, the company did not do so.

Accordingly, the application filed by Transit Systems Inc. in TV-180640 for Household Goods Carriers authority is dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements.
