Please find attached revised tariff pages associated with tariff revisions for G-60 Tariff Number 27 for Fiorito Enterprises, Inc & Rabanco Companies (dba Kent-Meridian Disposal Company, Republic Services of Kent, & Allied Waste Services of Kent). This proposed change in the tariff reflects a renewal of the temporary recycling processing fee surcharge to be in effect 180 days. This renewal is \$0.54/month which is \$0.13/month lower for Residential Customers and \$0.19/yard which is \$0.05/yard higher for Multi Family Customers from the previous approved recycle surcharge. The company will reapply for the surcharge after one year. The related accounting work papers are included in this submission to accompany the replacement tariff pages. We are asking that this rate become effective on January 1, 2019.
