



Rate Increase Notice

June 1, 2019

Dear Valued Customer,

Waste Management is pleased to be your yard waste collection provider. We value your business and welcome your feedback on our services.

Due to an increase in our cost to process your yard debris and food waste materials at our processor, Cedar Grove Composting, Inc. it is necessary to request an increase in our monthly collection rates. Accordingly, we have applied for an increase in our yard waste rates, subject to the review and approval of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC). If approved, the new monthly rates reflected below will become effective July 1, 2019.

<u>Monthly Service</u>	<u>Current Rate</u>	<u>Proposed Rate</u>
35- gallon cart	\$9.26	\$9.58
64-gallon cart	\$10.35	\$10.93
96-gallon cart	\$11.33	\$12.20

The UTC has the authority to set final rates that may be lower or higher than the proposed rates shown on the back of this letter, depending on the outcome of its investigation. You can comment by using the "Submit a Comment" feature at the commission's web site, at comments@utc.wa.gov or by using the contact information below. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the commissioners at an open meeting in Olympia, which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on June 27, 2019. If you choose to do so, you will have an opportunity to comment in person at this meeting. The UTC is committed to providing reasonable accommodation to participants with disabilities.
