Dear Customer,

Pt. Fosdick Water Co., Inc. has filed for approval from the WUTC ("Commission") to increase its revenue by \$62,735 annually. If approved, the increase will take effect September 1, 2019. This is a general rate increase. The rate increases are set forth in the table below.

Overall costs to provide service, such as wages, taxes and other factors, have increased and, as always, regulatory compliance costs continue to rise. This is the first rate increase since 2003.

The chart below sets forth the rates that are currently charged and what charges would be if the rate request is approved. The \$62,735 additional revenue represents a 52.8% increase in total service revenue. The Base charge is increasing by 70%. The first usage block is increasing by 44.44%. The second usage block is increasing by 31.58%. The third usage block is combined with the second block, so no increase. The final usage block is not increasing. Flat rate customers on Schedule 1 rates are increasing by 39.33%.
