Dear Senior Services Center of San Juan County:

On July 24, 2019, Senior Services Center of San Juan County, d/b/a Mullis Community Senior Services, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a Non-profit Bus carrier in the state of Washington.

On July 26, September 3 and October 10, 2019, the Commission sent Senior Services Center of San Juan County notices describing the application requirements the company had not satisfied. Despite this notice, Senior Services Center of San Juan County has not met the following requirements as of the date of this letter: Has not provided a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E).

Accordingly, the application filed by Senior Services Center of San Juan County in TN-190629 for Non-profit Bus authority is dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements.
