Dear Celebrity Access Transport LLC:

On March 5, 2020, Celebrity Access Transport LLC, d/b/a Celebrity Access Transport CAT, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a Charter and Excursion Bus carrier in the state of Washington.

On April 6, 2020, the Commission sent Celebrity Access Transport LLC notices describing the application requirements the company had not satisfied. Due to the circumstances of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the Governor's travel restrictions, Celebrity Access Transport LLC has not met the following requirements as of the date of this letter: provide proof-of-insurance.

Accordingly, the application filed by Celebrity Access Transport LLC in TE-200156 for Charter and Excursion Bus authority is dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements. The company's application fee has been refunded and the company is free to re-apply when pandemic-related conditions allow.
