Attached for filing with the Commission is an electronic copy of Avista Corporation's, dba Avista Utilities' ("Avista" or "the Company"), filing of its proposed revisions to the following electric tariff sheet, WN U-28:

Ninth Revision Sheet 92 Canceling Eighth Revision Sheet 92

The purpose of this filing is to increase the amount of the Company's electric "Low Income Rate Assistance Program" (LIRAP) funding by 7 percent in compliance with Commission Order No. 09, in Docket UE-190334. By way of background, Order No. 05 in Docket UE-150204 et. al. established a five-year plan and true-up schedule which required Avista to file revisions by August 15th of each year to Schedule 92 to increase LIRAP funding by 7 percent, beginning October 1, 2016 with annual funding increases through October 1, 2019. Order No. 09, in Docket UE-190334 extended the five-year funding plan through Avista's next GRC. Also included in this filing is a true-up of the estimated revenues collected for LIRAP to the actual collections for the prior October to September LIRAP program year.

The Company requests the Commission approve the proposed increase in rates and charges in Schedule 92 with an effective date of October 1, 2020. The estimated annual revenue change associated with this filing is an increase of approximately \$0.7 million, or an increase of 0.1% in overall billed rates. The proposed rate increase will have an average monthly bill impact of \$0.11

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for residential electric customers using 918 kWhs, or 0.1%. If approved, the average monthly bill would increase from \$82.91 to \$83.02.

Pursuant to WAC 480-100-194(1), a "Thirty-day Notice to Individual Customers", the Company will provide notice to customers, by way of a bill insert, in the August/September 2020 billing cycle, as well as a posting on the Company's website coincident with the date of this filing. Attached are the Company's workpapers supporting this proposal.
