
On November 1, 2021, Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC (“CCWA”) filed tariff revisions to its WN U-1, Lifeline tariff to limit, effective December 1, 2021, the Federal Lifeline credit amount to customers residing in certain census blocks where there is only one Lifeline provider in the census block, as set forth by the Federal Communications Commission’s (FCC) 2016 Lifeline Modernization Order.

Subsequent to CCWA’s filing, the FCC adopted and released on November 5, 2021, its Order DA-21-1389, to pause the phase-down of voice-only support for one year, until December 1, 2022, to give the FCC time to evaluate warranted longer-term modification of the Lifeline program. Because of this pause, all census blocks will continue to be eligible for voice-only Lifeline support. Accordingly, CCWA requests Docket UT-210825 be withdrawn.
