Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Our Company has been notified by Cowlitz County Public Works that the tipping fee at the Third Avenue Transfer Station will increase from \$55.81 to \$59.23 per ton, a 6.1% increase, effective January 1, 2022. We project this will increase revenue for the residential service by \$53,176 (1.76%); for commercial service by \$3,144 (1.88%); and drop box service by \$20,500 (6.13% pass through) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 11,700 residential, 400 commercial, and 40 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase for Waste Control, Inc. was approved by the Commission, October 1, 2018.

Attached are revised tariff pages and supporting documentation containing the revised rates. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective January 1, 2022.

Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2) (iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
