

IMPORTANT NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGE



March 22, 2022

Dear Large Volume Green Energy Customer,

Puget Sound Energy (PSE), on March 17, 2022, filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to increase rates under its Schedule 136 Large Volume Green Energy Purchase Rider, effective April 17, 2022. PSE is making this filing in order to update the monthly rate from \$0.0035 per kWh, which was set in 2016. If approved, the monthly rate would be \$0.0060 per kWh, an increase of \$0.0025 per kWh. This change is being proposed in order to adjust for changing conditions in the local renewable energy market which are making it increasingly difficult to source supply at the current price.
