Dear Magik Corp:

On July 20, 2022, Joswick, Charity, d/b/a Magik Relocation, and Magik Corp d/b/a Magik Relocation filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a joint application for reinstatement and transfer of temporary household goods carrier authority in the state of Washington. You have met the initial application requirements by completing the Household Goods training on November 10, 2020.

The Commission provisionally grants your application. Magik Corp is now authorized to operate on a **temporary** basis.

The Commission will evaluate whether Magik Corp qualifies for permanent authority. To qualify for permanent authority, your company must satisfy the following requirements:

1. Operate for at least six months.
2. Allow the Commission to review your business operations and records. Commission staff will review records and inspect vehicle(s), and you must receive a satisfactory safety rating as a result of that review.
3. Complete a criminal background check on each person Magik Corp employs or intends to employ. The Commission will not grant permanent authority if any company employee has been convicted of any crime within the past five years involving theft, burglary, assault, sexual misconduct, identity theft, fraud, false statements, or the manufacture, sale, or distribution of a controlled substance. Even if a conviction for any of these offenses is more than five years old, the Commission will not grant permanent authority if it determines that the nature or extent of the crime(s) will likely interfere with the proper operation of a household goods moving company.


4. Pay any outstanding monetary penalty or fee owed to the Commission.
5. Resolve all consumer complaints pending with the Commission.

Enclosed is a consumer survey to assist the Commission in evaluating Magik Corp's application. Please provide a copy of this survey to your first 10 customers and ask them to complete and mail it to the Commission at the address on the reverse side.

Magik Corp d/b/a Magik Relocation must comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
