Dear Customer:

Sunshine Disposal & Recycling has filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to increase rates in Spokane County effective October 1, 2024. This increase is to cover increased operating costs including labor, fuel, and equipment. Our last rate increase took effect January 1, 2024 and covered disposal fees only. Proposed rates are as follows:

The Commission has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher than the company's request, depending on the results of its investigation.
