Dear Mr. Killip:

Enclosed, please find revised pages, 2, 23, and 24 to the above-referenced tariff. These proposed revised tariff pages reflect the change in the commodity credit for residential customers receiving subscription recycling collection services. These tariff revisions reflect an increase in the recycling credit from <\$0.30> to <\$1.85> per month for residential customers. We are requesting that these tariff revisions go into effect on February 1, 2024. This decrease is jointly due to the change in commodity values, tonnages, and materials composition since the commodity credit adjustment on February 1, 2024. Furthermore, consistent with recent filings in other Waste Management tariffs; we are requesting with this filing that we estimate the projected revenues based on the revenues received over the most recent 12 months.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers. Additionally, I am including an LSN to allow the new credit to take effect on February 1, 2025 and for affected customers to be notified of this rate increase on their next regularly scheduled billing, upon approval by the Commission of this filing.
