Subject: Brem-Air Disposal, a division of Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (G-237); Tariff # 20

Enclosed are the revised tariff pages 2, 22 and 25 to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of these tariff revisions is to reflect the change in the commodity charges/ <credits> for residential and multi-family customers receiving recycling collection services. These tariff revisions reflect a change in the current recycling charge from \$2.20 per month to a credit of \$1.55 per month for residential customers and a change in the current recycling credit of \$0.85 per unit to a credit of \$0.55 per unit for multi-family customers.

The change in the commodity charge to a credit is jointly due to the change in commodity values, tonnages and materials composition since the commodity credit adjustment on November 1, 2024. We are filing the change in the commodity credit with an LSN requesting a proposed effective date of these tariff revisions be November 1, 2025.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers. Customers will be notified of the change in their recycling <credit> debit adjustment on their next regularly scheduled billing after approval by the Commission.
