This is to notify you of a proposed rate change for residential solid waste services. Should the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) approve our rate increase request, customers will experience a rate increase throughout all classes of service.

The proposed rate increase is 9.3%. The increase impacts rates as follows:

The last general rate increase was effective September 1, 2021. Since that time, the Company has experienced increases in all expenses, including but not limited to, wages and employee benefits, fuel, maintenance, and repair costs, and has invested in additional capital assets. If approved, the proposed rates will become effective on July 1, 2024.

Please note residential customers are currently billed on a quarterly basis. Effective July 1, 2021, and pending approval by the Washington and Utilities Transportation Commission, residential customers will be billed bi-monthly.
