Dear Espinoza, Amber Diane:

On February 2, 2026, Espinoza, Amber Diane, d/b/a Moving & More; M & M Movers, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a Household Goods Carriers carrier in the state of Washington.

On April 6, 2026, the Commission sent Espinoza, Amber Diane notices describing the application requirements the company had not satisfied. Despite this notice, Espinoza, Amber Diane has not met the following requirements as of the date of this letter: USDOT number; driver's license; vehicle list; financial statement; household goods training; proof of insurance; statements of support; application fee.

Accordingly, the application filed by Espinoza, Amber Diane in TV-260063 for Household Goods Carriers authority is dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements.
