Reference: Rulemaking to Revise Household Goods Carrier Rules - WUTC Docket TV-070466

The following are comments submitted by the Washington Movers Conference to proposed changes to WUTC **Tariff No. 15-B** contained in Docket TV-070466.

ITEM 55 – Miscellaneous Services Requested by the Customer Add after the word Tariff, such as shuttle service when circumstances make it physically impossible to pick-up or deliver a shipment using a standard moving vehicle(s) and a smaller vehicle(s) is required to transport (shuttle) between the two, ...

ITEM 90 – Carrier Liability for Household Goods and Customer Valuation Options. Change paragraph 3.c. to read "Loss or damage from insects, moths, vermin, mold, fungus or bacteria within the customer's belongings or that develop therein due to conditions present before the carrier picks up the customer's belongings; or to any bodily injury to the carrier's employees resulting from the aforementioned categories of infestation."

ITEM 95 - Bill of Lading.

Change Section 1, paragraph (B.)(3.) to read "Loss or damage from insects, moths, vermin, mold, fungus or bacteria within the customer's belongings or that develop therein due to conditions present before the carrier picks up the customer's belongings; or to any bodily injury to the carrier's employees resulting from the aforementioned categories of infestation."

ITEM 195, ITEM 195-A, ITEM 225 – Packing Charges/Container Prices
Request the addition of the following items to the "Type of Container" section –
Under Boxes, new items –
Base Lamp
Plasma Television

**NOTE:** The Washington Movers Conference would be willing to compile pricing data for the WUTC to use when determining Minimum and Maximum charges for the Tariff for the above items.
