GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE (Settlement and Evidentiary Hearing rescheduled for August 14, 2019)

MEMORANDUM

- NATURE OF PROCEEDING. On December 31, 2018, Northwest Natural Gas Company, d/b/a NW Natural, (NW Natural or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-6, Natural Gas Service. The purpose of the Company's filing is to increase rates and charges for natural gas service provided to customers in the state of Washington.
- 2 The Commission convened a prehearing conference on January 24, 2019. During the prehearing conference, the parties proposed a procedural schedule. On January 25, 2019, the Commission entered Order 03 adopting the procedural schedule proposed by the parties.
- 3 **MOTION.** On May 15, 2019, NW Natural filed an unopposed motion to modify the procedural schedule (Motion), explaining that NW Natural, Commission staff, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, and The Energy Project (collectively, Settling Parties) have reached a partial, multi-party settlement in principle.
- 4 According to NW Natural, the settlement in principle addresses all but one issue presented in the case. NW Natural states that Public Counsel has informed the Settling Parties that it may join the settlement agreement but does not yet have approval to do so. While the Settling Parties have also reached a partial, multi-party settlement in principle on the issue of decoupling, the issue remains contested by Public Counsel and will be litigated and presented to the Commission for resolution.

DISCUSSION

- 5 Under WAC 480-07-375(1)(b), parties may file procedural motions requesting that the Commission modify the procedural schedule in a proceeding. NW Natural states that it has conferred with the other parties in this docket and that all parties support the Motion.
- 6 Because all parties support NW Natural's Motion, and to aid in timely resolution of this proceeding, the Commission grants NW Natural's Motion and modifies the procedural schedule as indicated in Appendix A to this order.¹
- NOTICE OF HEARING. The evidentiary hearing previously set for August 14-15, 2019, is now styled Settlement and Evidentiary Hearing and is rescheduled for only August 14, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's Hearing Room, 621 Woodland Park Loop SE, Lacey, Washington.

ORDER

8 THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT Northwest Natural Gas Company, d/b/a NW Natural's Motion for Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule is GRANTED.
