6. Public Counsel submits a total of 758 public comments in the exhibit. Of these, 698 oppose the requested rate increase and 24 support the request. Thirty-two neither oppose nor support Puget Sound Energy's request and four of the comments were duplicative. Five individuals selected "Yes" in support of the rate increase when submitting online comments; however, the content of their comments appear to suggest opposition to the increase.<sup>2</sup>

Nevertheless, we have logged each customer's position as we received them and did not modify the tally detailed above.
