TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 6, 2008, Intelligent Community Services, Inc. (ICS), the Washington Independent Telecommunications Association, Inland Telephone Company and the Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed a joint issues list.
