For the Commission to state in official documents that spelling out the new charge for customers would "quickly result in lengthy and confusing bills" is disingenuous at best. At worst, it is an egregious breach of public trust and is promulgation of regulation that exceeds the scope of authority of the Commission. From what KING 5 indicated, PSE wanted to provide an explanation on its consumer billings as to the increased cost of natural gas, but WA UTC prohibited such a disclosure.
