On April 3, 2024, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Prehearing Conference (Notice). Additionally, the Notice failed to address the issue of intervenor funding and is amended to include the following paragraph:

INTERVENOR FUNDING: The Commission granted intervenor funding case certification in this matter to AWEC, NVEC, and The Energy Project in Order 04, Granting Requests for Case Certification (Order 04). Pursuant to the Washington Extended Interim Participatory Funding Agreement, in a proceeding with multiple phases such as this one, a grant of case certification encompasses the entire proceeding.¹ Any other party requesting case certification must file such request on or before April 23, 2024. The Commission will establish the deadline for filing any proposed budgets for this second phase at the prehearing conference.
