2 The administrative rules that this petition puts at issue are WAC § 480-07-
340, -355.

3 ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric
customers in the Pacific Northwest. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A.
Many members of ICNU purchase power from Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”), as indicated on
Attachment A.

4 ICNU’s member companies have a substantial interest in PSE’s proposed
Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism Annual Report for the six months ended December 31,
2006. Several ICNU members purchase power from PSE pursuant to cost of service rates.
The rates of these members could be affected by the Commission’s decision in this docket.
ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by
the Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism.

5 As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this
proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected
by any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding. It is in the
public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding. ICNU, therefore, requests that
the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene and make ICNU a party to this proceeding.


6 ICNU believes its participation in this proceeding will assist the Commission.
