## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO COMMISSION STAFF'S DISPUTE OF CONJUNCTIVE DEMAND SERVICE OPTION PILOT REPORT

(By February 12, 2021, at 5 p.m.)

Re: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy, Dockets UE-190529, UG-190530, UE-190274, UG-190275, UE-171225, UG-171226, UE-190991, and UG-190992 (consolidated)

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 8, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Final Order (Order 08) in the above-captioned dockets, which resolved all of the contested issues in Puget Sound Energy's (PSE or Company) general rate proceeding. Order 08, among other things, required PSE to file a report regarding its Conjunctive Demand Service Option Pilot Program (CDSO Pilot) within 90 days of the effective date of Order 08.

On January 14, 2021, PSE filed a report on its CDSO Pilot (Report), and on January 27, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the Report. In its letter, Staff objects to both the timeliness and content of the Report and recommends the Commission find that the Company has failed to comply with Order 08.

Under WAC 480-07-880(6), the Commission will provide an opportunity to respond to a compliance filing dispute raised by any party. Accordingly, parties may respond to Staff's letter disputing PSE's Report by 5 p.m. on Friday, February 12, 2021.

THE COMMISSION PROVIDES NOTICE that parties may file a response to Staff's letter disputing PSE's Conjunctive Demand Service Option Pilot Report by 5 p.m. on February 12, 2021.
