NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

TO ALL PARTIES:

Staff and Verizon (the "parties") notified the Commission by letter filed March 21, 2007, that they have reached a settlement in principle of all of the issues in these proceedings. They ask the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule pending the preparation, filing, and consideration of their proposed settlement agreement.

The Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule.
