Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On May 18, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 02, Extending Provisional Period in Docket TV-190858. Order 02 extended Americam Movers LLC's, (Americam or Company) application for provisional household goods operating authority for good cause, to allow the Company to demonstrate compliance with Order 01, by completing a random alcohol test.

On October 13, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) completed a focused review of Americam's random testing program and determined that the Company has complied with the random testing requirements.

Staff finds that Americam has satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and the conditions for permanent household goods moving authority.
