The Commission Staff responds to the comments made by Verizon in its September 8, 2003, letter. In that letter, Verizon states that the Commission should not permit Staff to reply to Verizon's response to Staff's Petition for Reconsideration. In its response to Staff's petition, Verizon concludes that the Commission does not have jurisdiction to consider Staff's petition. The Commission should permit Staff to respond to this statement (even though it is lodged in a footnote and without legal analysis) because the Staff's response will assist the Commission in reaching its decision on whether it should consider Staff's petition. Staff will not further argue the merits of its petition. Staff will submit its response to Verizon's conclusion regarding the Commission's jurisdiction by September 10, 2003.
