Dear Judge Friedlander:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that CenturyLink has decided to re-designate its supplemental response to Sprint DR No. 42 from “Highly Confidential” to “Confidential.” CenturyLink still maintains that the revenue number contained in the response is sufficiently granular enough (in terms of the small number of customers and the small geographic area involved) that it would normally merit highly confidential classification. However, given the relatively minor amount of revenue involved and in the interests of not burdening Your Honor with further contentious issues, CenturyLink is willing to re-designate this one response.

Notice of CenturyLink’s decision to downgrade the response to “Confidential” has been communicated to Counsel for Sprint via e-mail. Acknowledgment of that communication has been received. Therefore it would appear that the issue raised in Sprint’s pending Motion to Challenge Classification of CenturyLink Response to Sprint Data Request No. 42 has been rendered moot and no review or ruling by the Commission will be necessary.
