for Waiver of Accounting, Deposit and Reporting Requirements

Dear Mr. Danner:

In Docket No. UW-041384, under Order No. 03, the Commission approved a Settlement Agreement which contains certain accounting, deposit and reporting requirements related to the establishment of a conservation rate. The accounting requirements related to the calculation of an amount of "Excess Revenue" (as that term is defined in the Settlement Agreement) and holding such funds in a CIAC subaccount and to expend those funds for a list of particular purposes described in Paragraph 3.5 of the Settlement Agreement. In addition, Rainier View was required to submit semi-annual reports.

Under the new rate design proposed in UW-091466 (assuming it is approved), the Commission will do away with the conservation rate by approving a new rate design premised on meter sizes and incorporating three tiers of rates, all of which were to address Rainier View's overall revenue requirement. As a result, the "conservation rate" approved in Docket UW-041384 will be in effect in 2010 only for the month of May.


From Rainier View's perspective, it does not make sense to have specific, particular accounting rules and reporting requirements for one month of 2010 for a small amount of revenue. Therefore, Rainier View respectfully requests
