Commission Staff's Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 04 Docket

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On April 1, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 04, which assessed Sean Smith (Smith or Company) a penalty of \$2,000 for operating as a solid waste carrier without a certificate. Order 04 further suspended a \$1,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years on the conditions that: (1) the Company refrains permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and (2) Smith pays the \$500 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On March 1, 2021, the Company's \$500 penalty was paid in full. To date, Smith has refrained permanently from further operations as a solid waste carrier in this state. Staff finds that Smith satisfied the conditions of Order 04 and recommends that the \$1,500 suspended penalty be waived.
