## RE: Docket UE-220441—Compliance Filing

PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp) submits to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) proposed revisions to its electric Schedule 97, Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism Adjustment, in accordance with WAC 480-07-880. PacifiCorp respectfully requests an effective date of January 1, 2025.

Fifth Revision of Sheet No. 97.1 Schedule 97 Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism Adjustment

In compliance with Order 01 in Docket UE-220441, PacifiCorp set a rate for Schedule 97 to collect approximately \$25.6 million over 24 months, effective January 1, 2023. Accordingly, PacifiCorp is now submitting a revised tariff to reduce Schedule 97 as the 24-month amortization comes to an end on December 31, 2024.

This filing will result in an overall average decrease of approximately 3.2 percent to PacifiCorp's Washington customers. If approved, residential customers using approximately 1,200 kWh per month will see a bill decrease of approximately \$3.83 per month.
