## **MEMORANDUM**

The Commission on September 25, 1992, entered its SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ACCEPTING AMENDED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND AFFILIATED INTEREST AGREEMENTS. The Commission's Second Supplemental Order was conditioned upon the commitment of GTE NORTHWEST INCORPORATED (GTE-NW or company) to implement within one year of the entry of that Order a "service guarantee credit" and a "credit allowance for interruption of service."

On June 11, 1993, GTE-NW filed with the Commission tariffs designed to implement the service guarantee credit and credit allowance for interruption of service, effective July 12, 1993. Docket No. UT-930687, revises Tariff WN U-10, and Docket No. UT-930688, revises Tariff WN U-13.

The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by GTE-NW on June 11, 1993, are in accordance with the intent of the Commission's Second Supplemental Order. Therefore, the Commission should approve the tariff revisions to become effective as filed.

## ORDER

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 1. The tariff revisions filed in Docket Nos. UT-930687 and UT-930688 on June 11, 1993, with effective dates of July 12, 1993, are approved as filed;
- 2. The tariff sheets shall be refiled by the company and shall bear the following notation on each sheet of the tariff: "By Authority of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission in Docket No. UT-910499."

3. That jurisdiction is retained by the Commission to effectuate the provisions of this order.
