Unopposed Motion to Extend Compliance Deadline

- 1. Under WAC 480-07-385, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Co. moves for an order extending the compliance filing deadline established in Order 06 from November 13, 2017, to December 1, 2017.
- 2. In Order 06, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission accepted in part, and rejected in part, tariff revisions proposed by Pacific Power.
- 3. Order 06 instructed Pacific Power to work with Staff and the intervenors to: (1) develop procedures for resolving disputes about proposed Stranded Cost Recovery Fees; and (2) develop more detailed policies and procedures regarding decommissioning company facilities after a disconnection. See Order 06, ¶¶ 140 and 142.
- 4. Order 06 instructed Pacific Power to submit a compliance filing within 30 days of the order, or November 13, 2017.
- 5. Under Wash. Admin. Code § 480-07-385, the Commission may extend a deadline if the requesting party demonstrates good cause and that no other party or the Commission will be prejudiced.
- 6. Here, good cause exists to extend the compliance filing deadline to December 1, 2017. Pacific Power, Staff, and other intervenors have exchanged multiple drafts of the dispute resolution and decommissioning language, and much progress has been made towards resolving the issues raised in

Order 06.

- 7. The parties agree that, in an effort to minimize compliance filing disputes, additional time would be beneficial to allow for continued discussions regarding the dispute resolution and decommissioning language. Good cause accordingly exists to allow the parties to continue their productive efforts to comply with the Commission's expectations in Order 06.
- 8. Pacific Power has been authorized to represent that Staff supports this motion, and no party to this docket opposes it. Therefore, no party will be prejudiced.
- 9. Pacific Power, therefore, respectfully asks for an order extending the November 13, 2017, compliance filing deadline to December 1, 2017.
