Dear Judge Howard:

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Co, The Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, and The Energy Project (hereinafter and collectively referred to as the "Settling Parties") have reached a full multiparty settlement in principle in the docket referenced above and are notifying the Commission pursuant to WAC 480-07-740(2)(c). The Public Counsel Unit of the Washington Attorney General's Office ("Public Counsel") has not joined the settlement.

The Settling Parties intend to file settlement documents and any supporting testimony, or in the alternative to provide the Commission with an update regarding the settlement, by November 8, 2021.
