**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO FILE WRITTEN COMMENTS**  
**(By Friday, December 15, 2017, at 12 p.m.)**

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Pacific Power & Light Company*  
Docket UE-161204

TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 12, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered its Final Order, Order 06, in Docket UE-161204. Order 06 required, among other things, that Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company) work with Commission staff (Staff) and intervenors to develop procedures for resolving disputes related to Stranded Cost Recovery Fee (SCRF) calculations, and to develop more detailed policies and procedures related to decommissioning Company facilities following permanent disconnection. Order 06 instructed Pacific Power to submit a compliance filing within 30 days, or by November 13, 2017. On November 14, 2017, the Commission entered Order 08, which extended the Company's deadline until December 1.

On December 1, 2017, the Company submitted its compliance filing. In its cover letter, Pacific Power notes that the parties were unable to resolve certain issues. Specifically, the parties disagree about whether the Commission must review and approve all SCRF calculations, and whether there are circumstances in which the Company should be permitted to abandon and decommission facilities in place following permanent disconnection. The Company acknowledged that other parties intend to file comments to address their concerns, and requests the right to respond to such comments.

In light of the parties' disagreement about whether the Company's filing complies with Order 06, we invite all parties, including the Company, to submit comments outlining their respective positions no later than **12 p.m. on Friday, December 15, 2017**. The Commission will consider only one round of comments.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That all parties may file comments related to Pacific Power & Light Company's compliance filing in Docket UE-161204 no later than 12 p.m. on Friday, December 15, 2017.**
