**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO SUBMIT COMMENTS  
(By Thursday, September 27, 2007, at 3:00 p.m.)**

Re: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation*, Docket UG-060256

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 14, 2007, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade) filed an addendum to its proposed Conservation Plan and associated tariff sheets to implement its conservation programs and decoupling mechanism. Cascade requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the Addendum and allow the tariffs to become effective on October 1, 2007.

On Monday, September 24, 2007, Public Counsel filed comments on Cascade's filing, requesting that Cascade not begin to record deferrals under the decoupling mechanism until January 2008. Public Counsel also requests the Commission require Cascade to clarify further its accounting of deferrals under the decoupling mechanism.

**The Commission provides an opportunity for parties to submit written comments addressing Public Counsel's comments no later than 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 27, 2007.** The Commission requires responses in this abbreviated period to address Cascade's filing prior to the requested October 1 effective date. Parties may submit documents electronically on September 27, and must file an original, plus eleven paper copies, of the document with the Commission by Noon on the following business day. Finally, to perfect filing, parties must provide courtesy copies to the presiding administrative law judge and advisory staff as well as the parties to the proceeding.
