TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 16, 2010, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01 Granting Accounting Petition (Order 01) in docket UG-100589. Order 01, among other things, required Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade or Company) to file semi-annual expense reports for its environmental remediation deferral project. On March 29, 2018, the Commission entered Order 02, Order Granting Cascade's Motion to Amend Order 01 (Order 02), which allowed Cascade to reduce the reporting to an annual report that includes a summary of the status of remediation.

On February 28, 2019, Cascade filed an environmental remediation deferral report, including a summary of the status of remediation (Report).

On March 4, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the report and believes that the Report complies with the requirements of Order 01 and Order 02.

The Commission accepts the Report as in compliance with Order 01 and Order 02.
