Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on March 28, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 03 imposing a suspended penalty against Seattle 7 Days Limo due to the company's failure to comply with the conditions set out in Order 02, dated January 14, 2019. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated May 16, 2019, indicating that the balance of \$10,000 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$10,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$10,000 balance.
