Avista has executed five contracts supporting the implementation of its Washington advanced metering system. The Company hired the Boreas Group to assist in planning and preparation of technical specifications for AMI vendors and equipment, for which contract materials are provided as Staff DR 162C Confidential Attachment A. Avista purchased its meter data management system software application from Oracle Utilities, and the related contract materials are provided as Staff DR 162C Confidential Attachment B.
