Witness Archuleta testified about the importance of "leveraging" state and federal funds for Low-Income Weatherization. GA-1T at 10:5–8. Is it PSE's position that PSE cannot increase funding for its LIW program as proposed by Mr. Colton without jeopardizing access to state and federal funds that support this program?

## Response:

No, that is not Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE") position. PSE can and does increase funding for its Low-Income Weatherization Program.
