**MEMORANDUM**

1 **NATURE OF PROCEEDING:** Docket UT-063061 involves Qwest Corporation’s (Qwest) request for arbitration of an interconnection agreement with Eschelon Telecom, Inc., (Eschelon) pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

2 **PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND:** Orders 09 and 11 entered in this proceeding established the procedural schedule for this docket. On October 25, 2007, the Administrative Law Judge contacted the parties to determine if they were amenable to extending for 60 days the deadline for issuing the Arbitrator’s Report and Order given caseload and staffing constraints. The Administrative Law Judge indicated that all other deadlines would be extended for a commensurate period of time. Both parties agreed to the extension of the procedural schedule.

- 3 **COMMISSION DECISION:** Absent objection by the parties, the procedural schedule should be extended by 60 days to accommodate the caseload and staffing constraints of the Commission. The revised procedural schedule is attached to this Order as Appendix A.
