The only other issue is a portion of 9-39. Issues 9-37, 9-37(a), 9-37(b), 9-38, 9-39 (except caps), 9-40, 9-41, 9-42 are the wire center issues that are on hold in this proceeding until a decision is made on the wire center issues. Although those issues are on hold, the Parties have agreed to a single compliance filing of the ICA after all of the issues, including these wire center issues, are decided (and that agreement was approved in an order approving the motion for a single compliance filing). In the Minnesota arbitration, for example, the ALJs ruled on the other issues earlier, a wire center ruling was later reached, and the compliance filing of the ICA occurred afterward. Per the parties' agreement, the ICA is not filed and does not go into effect until all of the issues are decided, including the wire center issues.
